Code of Conduct

As a volunteer representing Isle Listen, you play a vital role in promoting our mission and ensuring a positive experience for all event participants. To maintain professionalism, respect, and safety, all volunteers are expected to follow this Code of Conduct:

Represent the Charity Positively

- · Act as an ambassador for the charity at all times.
- Be respectful, friendly, and welcoming to all guests, donors, fellow volunteers, and staff.
- Wear appropriate clothing and any required volunteer identification during events.

Maintain Professionalism

- Arrive on time and complete assigned duties reliably.
- Follow instructions from event organisers and ask questions if anything is unclear.
- Do not consume alcohol or drugs while volunteering and avoid behaviour e.g. swearing, that could reflect poorly on the organisation.

Respect Confidentiality and Privacy

- Keep any sensitive or personal information you learn about guests or the charity confidential. Speak to an Isle Listen member of staff should you require any guidance or have any concerns.
- Do not share internal event details or donor information without authorisation.

Ensure Safety and Inclusivity

- Be alert to safety concerns and report hazards or emergencies to event staff immediately, or the emergency services where appropriate.
- Treat everyone with respect regardless of age, gender, race, religion, ability, or background.
- Do not engage in harassment, discrimination, or any form of inappropriate behaviour.

Act with Integrity

- Do not solicit personal donations or promote personal causes during charity events.
- Handle all money, materials, or equipment with care and honesty if you are assigned such responsibilities.

Communicate Issues Promptly

- If you encounter any problems or are unable to fulfil your duties, notify the event coordinator as soon as possible.
- Report any misconduct or concerns to charity staff confidentially.
