



Event Waiver & Acknowledgement of Risk

1. Please listen carefully to the event briefing and instructions given by the organisers on the day and follow their guidance.
2. We will be taking photographs on the day which will be shared on our social media and sent to local and UK media. If you do not want your photograph to be used, please make this clear to the person taking the photograph so that it can be deleted straight away.
3. We will have First Aiders on hand nearby should they be required.
4. If you have any pre-existing medical conditions that may affect your ability to take part in this event, please consult with your doctor before participating.
5. If there is an emergency, follow the instructions of the organisers and the venue procedures. If you need assistance, alert one of the event staff.
6. Do not drink alcohol or take drugs before or during the event. This can impair your judgment and increase the risk of accidents.
7. Please be careful with any valuable items and leave them in your car if possible, Isle Listen will not be held responsible for the loss or damage of any personal items.

Acknowledgement of Risk

I hereby acknowledge that participation in The Isle of Man Dodgeball Championship (IOMDC) involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical contact, falls, collisions, and the possibility of injury (e.g., sprains, bruises, broken bones). I voluntarily choose to participate in this event fully aware of these risks.

Release of Liability

In consideration for being allowed to participate in IOMDC, I hereby waive any claims against and discharge from liability the event organisers, sponsors, volunteers, venue, and any affiliated parties from any and all liability, claims, or demands for injuries, damages, or losses arising from my participation in this event, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.

Medical Consent

I certify that I am physically fit to take part in this activity. I authorise event staff to administer first aid or seek medical treatment on my behalf in the event of an emergency.

Code of Conduct

I agree to follow all rules of the competition, act respectfully toward other participants and organisers, and understand that unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour may result in my removal from the event.



Fundraising Payment Method

Fundraising Payment Option

Team Participation

Fundraising activities are encouraged as a means of promoting team engagement and building team spirit ahead of the event.

Alternative Payment Option

Participants who do not wish to fundraise may instead pay the registration fee directly or request an invoice. These options must be selected on the online registration form.

Responsibility for Compliance

Teams selecting the fundraising option are responsible for ensuring that all activities comply with local laws, regulations, and any relevant fundraising guidelines.

Fundraising Deadline

Where the fundraising payment option is selected, all fundraising activities must be completed and funds totalling the full registration fee must be received by Isle Listen no later than **Friday 24th April**.

(Please note that if you wish to continue fundraising after reaching the registration fee total, any additional donations may be submitted following the event).

Non-Receipt of Funds

Failure to submit the required fundraising amount by the stated deadline will result in a requirement to pay the outstanding registration fee directly via BACS, Cheque or Cash.

Registration Fees

An early-bird registration fee of £265 applies until 2nd January, after which the standard registration fee of £299 will be charged.
